

**BOURNVILLE INFANT SCHOOL PUPIL PREMIUM GRANT**  
**ACADEMIC YEAR 2012/13 (September 2012 to August 2013)**

Additional funding to improve the educational attainment of underperforming pupils has been received from the government through the Pupil Premium Grant. This allocation is based on the numbers of pupils in reception to year 2, who have been entitled to Free School Meals since January 2007 (Ever 6 FSM), as recorded on the census.

An additional allocation (£250 in 2012/13 & estimated £300 in 2013/14 Financial Years\*) is also made for pupils of service personnel. "Looked After Children" also receive allocations (of £623 in 2013/13 & £900 in 2013/14 Financial Years\*) who meet the LAC criteria.

Total funding of £28,059 has been received, this includes funding received in the Financial Years 2012/13 of £13,809 (Part year - September 2012 to March 2013, 7/12ths of £623 = £363) and estimated funding to be received in the 2013/14 Financial year of £14,250 (Part year – April 2013 to March 2014).
