Dear Parents

As part of their topic on Toys, a trip has been organised for Year 1 to visit Sudbury Museum of Childhood in Ashbourne, Derbyshire. This will support the history element of the curriculum 'changes within living memory'. It will also provide them with valuable hands on experience of toys through the ages.

The visit will take place on **Thursday 16th November (Swans and Owls) and Friday 17th November (Robins)**. Children will leave school at approximately 8.30am, so will need to be dropped off at school at **8.20am**, and will return by 4.00pm. Children should wear school uniform and strong footwear. A sandwich lunch will be provided, however if you would like to provide your own packed lunch from home, please indicate below.

The total cost for this trip is **£16.99** per pupil which we ask you to pay via Parent Pay. This breaks down as follows:

- Coach: £9.39
- Insurance: £1.50
- Entry: £3.70
- Workshop: £2.40

Please complete the consent via parentpay when making your payment by **Friday 3rd November**. We must receive consent for **every child**. If we do not have consent then we are not allowed to take your child off school premises.
