Art

This half term the children will be told the Willow pattern story and how the story links to the willow pattern plate design. They will have the opportunity to discuss their likes and dislikes of the willow pattern plate and will experiment using pencil how to create lines of varying thickness and style, for example, wavy, straight and curved. Children will be encouraged to experiment with varying pressure and using different grades of pencil. The children will be looking at the colour used on the willow pattern plate and will be mixing paint to achieve different shades of blue by adding black or white. Their final product will be a willow pattern plate using their own design.

Geography

This half term, the children will be learning all about China. They will be learning the names of the continents and the oceans and comparing their locality with one in China. They will learn about the climate, food, people and culture.

Music

This half term the children will be focussing on the musical elements of listening (aural memory), pulse, rhythm and beat. They should practise combining pulse and rhythm.

VISITS/OTHER

The children will be learning about and listening to stories by the authors of the half term Janet and Alan Ahlberg.
