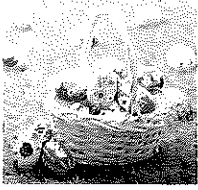
On Monday next week, Reception are holding their Spring play and learn. This is an ideal opportunity for Reception parents to join in with their child's learning.

Have fun making your Easter Bonnets this weekend!

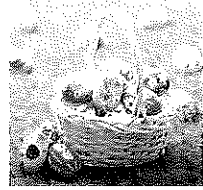
## Update
