After half-term we will be trialling a new system at lunchtimes across both schools.

All children who have hot meals will eat in the dining room in the Junior School building and all children who bring a packed lunch will eat in the hall in the Infant School. There are a number of benefits to this change:-

- Significant savings on our catering contract; we are constantly striving to identify financial savings across both Schools.
- The children have expressed, through School Council meetings, a wish to spend more time with friends and siblings across the key stages.
- Infant meals will not have to be transported from the Junior School to the Infant School.

Lunchtime supervisors and servers will be stationed in both buildings so that there are familiar adults available and SLT will be monitoring for the first few weeks to evaluate the success of the trial.
