

### Music

This half term the children will be focussing on the musical elements of listening (aural memory), pulse, rhythm and beat. They should practise combining pulse and rhythm.



### Art

This half term, the children will be looking at the work of the sculptor Henry Moore. They will be thinking about their own family group and making a sculpture from plasticine in the style of Henry Moore.

### History

This half term, the children will be learning about historical people and places in their own locality. They will learn about George Cadbury and the history of homes through a visit to Selly Manor. They will also learn about the life of Florence Nightingale and Mary



### Computing

This half term the children will be learning how to follow and create simple instructions on the computer. They will learn that an algorithm is a precise, step-by-step set of instructions used to solve a problem or achieve an objective, and correcting problems is called 'debugging'. With these skills, they will create and solve challenges involving programs that use directional keys.

### PE

PE will be Tuesday morning taught by our sports coach Chris Coley and Wednesday of Friday afternoon taught by the regular class teacher.

### Geography

The children will be studying the geography of the school and it's grounds and the key human and physical features of the surrounding area of Bournville. They will be learning about and drawing maps.
