

Art

This half term the children will be creating art work for their Summer Show 'The Jungle Book'. They will be exploring paint techniques such as stippling and learning different brush strokes to make masks and props for the show. They will explore making paints of different thickness and colour mixing.



Science

This half term the children will be planning an experiment to investigate what happens to vegetables over time. They will decide what makes a fair test and carry out the experiment, making predictions and drawing conclusions.

Computing

This half term, the children will be learning how to tell stories by using different media. They will explore ebooks, and see how digital content can be presented in different forms. The children will make a fact file on the non-fiction aspects of the current topic, before exploring what makes an effective presentation. They will finally present what they have learned to the class.
