

## Music

This half term the children will be learning some new songs and thinking about pitch and tempo. We will be working on compositions and organising sounds.



## Art

The children will be looking at the painting The Scream by Edvard Munch and using pastels to recreate the image in the style of the artist. They will be using different mediums to create smoke effects linked to the Fire of London.

## PE

## Geography

## History

## Science

The children will be finding out about animals. They should notice that animals (including humans) have offspring. They will be learning about the basic needs of animals for survival and the importance of exercise, healthy eating and hygiene.
